POST Rule 9 - Revocation of Peace Officer Certification: Pursuant to § 24-31-305(2)(a), C.R.S., a Colorado peace officer certification issued pursuant to subsection (1) or (1.3) of this section or 24-31-308 shall be suspended or revoked by the POST Board if the certificate holder has been convicted of a felony at any time, or has been convicted on or after July 1, 2001, of any misdemeanor described in subsection (1.5) of § 24-31-305, C.R.S. For purposes of this Rule 9, a deferred judgment and sentencing agreement, deferred prosecution agreement, or pretrial diversion agreement concerning a felony or any misdemeanor described in (1.5) of § 24-31-305, whether pending or successfully completed, also support the suspension or revocation of a Colorado peace officer certification. A Colorado peace officer certification may also be suspended or revoked if pursuant to § 24-31-305(2.5), C.R.S., a law enforcement agency has found, by clear and convincing evidence, that the certificate holder has knowingly made an untruthful statement concerning a material fact while testifying under oath, or during an internal affairs investigation or comparable administrative investigation; or knowingly omitted a material fact on an official criminal justice record, or has otherwise failed to meet the certification requirements established by the Board. A Colorado peace officer certification may also be surrendered pursuant to § 24-31-305.

Misdemeanor Matters:

1. M25-03, Taylor Bertsch, Certification PID CO-6436-6310. On March 7, 2025, Respondent entered into a deferred sentence agreement for one count of §18-9-111(1)(a) C.R.S. – Harassment, a misdemeanor, in Alamosa County Court case number 2024M467. The Respondent was employed as a Peace Officer at the time of offense (Date of Offense: October 26, 2024, Alamosa Police Department Separation Date: December 5, 2024). The Respondent did comply with POST Order to Show Cause No. M25-03 by appearing at a Show Cause Hearing on June 9, 2025. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of Taylor Bertsch's Colorado Peace Officer Certification, PID CO-6436-6310. Chief Dingfelder Recuse

The certificate holders in the following matters did <u>not</u> appear at the show cause hearing or indicate any intent to oppose the revocation. Unless any member objects and asks to consider one or all of these matters separately, they will all be presented to this Board as a group.

Felony Matters:

- 1. F25-08, Karen Gillespie, Certification PID CO-109779. On January 29, 2025, Respondent entered into a deferred sentence agreement for one count of §18-3-206 C.R.S. Felony Menacing, a felony, and plead guilty to one count of §18-9-111(1)(a) C.R.S. Harassment, a misdemeanor, in El Paso County District Court case number 2024CR3821. The Respondent was not employed as a Peace Officer at the time of offense (Date of Offense: September 8, 2024). The Respondent did not comply with POST Order to Show Cause No. F25-08 by failing to appear at a Show Cause Hearing on September 30, 2025. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of Karen Gillespie's Colorado Peace Officer Certification, PID CO-109779.
- 2. F25-09, Timothy Johnson, Certification PID CO-128310. On June 16, 2025, Respondent plead guilty to one count of §18-18-405(1),(2)(c)(I)C.R.S. Possession with Intent to Distribute Schedule I/II, a felony, in Arapahoe County District Court case number 2024CR1803 and Respondent plead guilty to one count of §18-4-401(1),(2)(g) C.R.S. Theft \$5,000-\$20,000, a felony, in Arapahoe County District Court case number 2024CR2228. The Respondent was not employed as a Peace Officer at the time of offense (Dates of Offense: July 4, 2024 and July 27, 2024). The Respondent did not comply with POST Order to Show Cause No. F25-09 by failing to appear at a Show Cause Hearing on October 2, 2025. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of Timothy Johnson's Colorado Peace Officer Certification, PID CO-128310.
- 3. F25-10, Jared Palma, Certification PID CO-135176. On July 11, 2025, Respondent entered into a deferred sentence agreement for one count of §18-6-403(3)(b.5),(5)(b)(II) C.R.S. Sexual Exploitation of a Child, a felony, in Arapahoe County District Court case number 2024CR1348. The Respondent was not employed as a Peace Officer at the time of offense (Date of Offense: November 24, 2023). The Respondent did not comply with POST Order to Show Cause No. F25-10 by failing to appear at a Show Cause Hearing on October 2, 2025. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of Jared Palma's Colorado Peace Officer Certification, PID CO-135176.

4. F25-11, Keith Sandford, Certification PID CO-7266-9387. On July 18, 2025, Respondent entered into a deferred sentence agreement for one count of §18-3-203(1)(i) C.R.S. – Assault in the Second Degree - Strangulation, a felony, and plead guilty to one count of §18-3-204(1)(a) C.R.S.- Assault in the Third Degree, a misdemeanor, in Arapahoe County District Court case number 2023CR2100. The Respondent was employed as a Peace Officer at the time of offense (Date of Offense: September 7, 2023, Empire Police Department Separation Date: September 8, 2023). The Respondent did not comply with POST Order to Show Cause No. F25-11 by failing to appear at a Show Cause Hearing on October 7, 2025. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of Keith Sandford's Colorado Peace Officer Certification, PID CO-7266-9387.

<u>Misdemeanor Matters:</u>

- 1. M25-06, Richard Gzybowski, Certification PID CO-135165. On April 8, 2025, Respondent entered into a deferred sentence agreement for one count of §18-3-204(1)(a) C.R.S. Assault in the Third Degree, a misdemeanor, in Jefferson County Court case number 2024M5785. The Respondent was not employed as a Peace Officer at the time of offense (Date of Offense: October 4, 2024). The Respondent did not comply with POST Order to Show Cause No. M25-06 by failing to appear at a Show Cause Hearing on August 14, 2025. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of Richard Gzybowski's Colorado Peace Officer Certification, PID CO-135165.
- 2. M25-07, William Hill, Certification PID CO-107613. On July 10, 2025, Respondent plead guilty to one count of §18-9-111(1)(f) C.R.S. Harassment, a misdemeanor, in Mesa County Court case number 2024M2347. The Respondent was not employed as a Peace Officer at the time of offense (Date of Offense: August 13, 2024). The Respondent did not comply with POST Order to Show Cause No. M25-07 by failing to appear at a Show Cause Hearing on October 1, 2025. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of William Hill's Colorado Peace Officer Certification, PID CO-107613.

Untruthfulness Matters:

- U25-28, Daniel Hook, Certification PID CO-1252-4403. On July 28, 2025, the Pueblo Police Department notified Colorado Peace Officer Standards & Training the Respondent knowingly made an untruthful statement concerning a material fact OR knowingly omitted a material fact during an internal affairs investigation on June 12, 2025 (Date of Separation: July 1, 2025). The respondent did not request an Administrative Hearing regarding this matter. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of Daniel Hook's Colorado Peace Officer Certification, PID CO-1252-4403.
- 2. U25-31, Jacob Golden, Certification PID CO-045-709. On August 13, 2025, the Weld County Sheriff's Office notified Colorado Peace Officer Standards & Training the Respondent knowingly made an untruthful statement concerning a material fact OR knowingly omitted a material fact during an internal affairs investigation on July 15, 2025 (Date of Separation: July 29, 2025). The respondent did not request an Administrative Hearing regarding this matter. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of Jacob Golden's Colorado Peace Officer Certification, PID CO-045-709.

3. U25-32, Temmo Cramer, Certification PID CO-724-005. On August 14, 2025, the Colorado Springs Police Department notified Colorado Peace Officer Standards & Training the Respondent knowingly made an untruthful statement concerning a material fact OR knowingly omitted a material fact on an official criminal justice record on February 7, 2025. (Date of Separation: August 1, 2025). The respondent did not request an Administrative Hearing regarding this matter. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of Temmo Cramer's Colorado Peace Officer Certification, PID CO-724-005.

POST Suspension of Peace Officer Certification: Pursuant to \$24-31-904(2)(a)(I) C.R.S. a Colorado peace officer certification issued pursuant to subsection (1) or (1.3) of \$24-31-305 C.R.S. or \$24-31-308 C.R.S. shall be suspended by the POST Board if the certificate holder has been convicted of or pleads guilty or nolo contendere to a crime involving the unlawful use or threatened use of physical force or a crime involving the failure to intervene in the use of unlawful force and the incident did not result in serious bodily injury or death to another person. For purposes of this Rule 5, pursuant to \$24-31-904(4) a deferred judgement, deferred prosecution agreement, or pretrial diversion agreement for a crime involving the use of physical force or a crime involving the failure to intervene in the unlawful use of force also support the suspension of a Colorado peace officer certification.

1. M24-12, Dat Truong, Certification PID CO-5338-4607. On December 16, 2024, Respondent was sentenced after being found guilty following a jury trial of one count of §18-9-111(1)(a) C.R.S. – Harassment – strike/shove/kick, a misdemeanor, in Adams County Court case number 2024M435. The Respondent was employed as a Peace Officer at the time of offense (Date of Offense: November 4, 2023, Denver Police Department, Separation Date: November 21, 2024). The Respondent did not comply with POST Order to Show Cause No. M24-12 by failing to appear at a Show Cause Hearing on February 4, 2025. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends a seven (7) year suspension of Dat Truong's Colorado Peace Officer Certification, PID CO-5338-4607. Chief Thomas recuse.

Voluntary Relinquishments:

1. VR25-10, Nicholas Smith, Certification PID CO-8052-0040. July 26, 2023, the Alamosa Police Department notified Colorado Peace Officer Standards & Training the Respondent knowingly made an untruthful statement concerning a material fact OR knowingly omitted a material fact on an official criminal justice record on November 28, 2022. (Date of Separation: January 31, 2023). Prior to an administrative hearing in this matter, the Respondent voluntarily relinquished his Colorado Peace Officer Certification.

Administrative Hearing Officer Decisions:

 E24-07, Rusty Waters, Certification PID CO-6324-2201. On July 19, 2024, the Thornton Police Department notified Colorado Peace Officer Standards & Training the Respondent used unlawful physical force on February 8, 2024 (*Date of Separation: August 26, 2024*). The respondent requested an Administrative Hearing, which was held on July 22, 2025. An initial order recommending revocation of Mr. Waters' Peace Officer Certification was issued on September 4, 2025. A Final Order of Revocation was issued on October 8, 2025.

- 1. E24-09, Steven Anderson, PID CO-139554. Hearing was conducted on May 19, 2025. Hearing Officer issued an Initial Decision on June 3, 2025. The respondent appealed the Initial Decision by filing exceptions. The parties have filed briefs on exceptions. The matter is before the Board to address the exceptions and determine whether to affirm, set aside, or modify the decision. Chief Thomas Recuse
- 2. U22-26, Vincente Rodriguez, PID CO-1786-8078. Hearing was conducted on April 28 through 29, 2025. Hearing Officer issued an Amended Ruling/Initial Decision on May 28, 2025. The respondent appealed the Amended Ruling/Initial Decision by filing exceptions. The parties have filed briefs on exceptions. The matter is before the Board to address the exceptions and determine whether to affirm, set aside, or modify the decision.
