POST Rule 9 - Revocation of Peace Officer Certifications: Pursuant to § 24-31-305(2)(a), C.R.S., a Colorado peace officer certification issued pursuant to subsection (1) or (1.3) of this section or 24-31-308 shall be suspended or revoked by the POST Board if the certificate holder has been convicted of a felony at any time, or has been convicted on or after July 1, 2001, of any misdemeanor described in subsection (1.5) of § 24-31-305, C.R.S. A Colorado peace officer certification may also be suspended or revoked if pursuant to § 24-31-305(2.5), C.R.S., a law enforcement agency has found, by clear and convincing evidence, that the certificate holder has knowingly made an untruthful statement concerning a material fact while testifying under oath, or during an internal affairs investigation or comparable administrative investigation; or knowingly omitted a material fact on an official criminal justice record, or has otherwise failed to meet the certification requirements established by the Board. A Colorado peace officer certification may also be surrendered pursuant to § 24-31-305. For purposes of this Rule 9, a deferred judgment and sentencing agreement, deferred prosecution agreement, or pretrial diversion agreement concerning a felony or any misdemeanor described in (1.5) of § 24-31-305, whether pending or successfully completed, also support the suspension or revocation of a Colorado peace officer certification.

Felony Convictions:

 No. F22-03, Adam Charles Hanna, Certification PID CO-140042. On January 25, 2022, Respondent was granted pretrial diversion after pleading guilty to one count of §18-5-102(1)(e) Forgery – Government issued Document, a Felony, and one count of §18-5-113(1)(b)(II) Criminal Impersonation – Gain Benefit, a Felony, and one count of §18-8-404 Official Misconduct I, a Misdemeanor, in Case No. 2021CR5 in the Cheyenne District Court. The respondent was employed as a peace officer on the date of the offense (Date of Offense: January 1, 2020, Cheyenne County Sheriff's Office, Separated January 31, 2020). The respondent has complied with POST Show Cause Order No. F22-03 by appearing at the scheduled Show Cause Hearing on May 3, 2022. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of Adam Charles Hanna's Colorado Peace Officer Certification, PID CO-140042.

The certificate holders in the following matters did <u>**not**</u> appear at the show cause hearing or indicate any intent to oppose the revocation. Unless any member objects and asks to consider one or all of these matters separately, they will all be presented to this Board as a group.

Felony Convictions:

 No. F22-04, Brian Matthew Dominguez, Certification PID CO-137902. On March 24, 2022, Respondent was granted a deferred sentence after pleading guilty to one count of §18-3-206(1)(a)/(b) Felony Menacing – Real/Simulated weapon, a Felony, in Case No. 2020CR208 in the Garfield District Court. The respondent was employed as a peace officer on the date of the offense (Date of Offense: April 23, 2020, Kersey Police Department, Separated April 24, 2020). The respondent has not complied with POST Show Cause Order No. F22-04 by failing to appear at the scheduled Show Cause Hearing on July 11, 2022. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of Brian Matthew Dominguez's Colorado Peace Officer Certification, PID CO-137902.

- No. F22-05, Michael R. Benson, Certification PID CO-134872. On April 7, 2022, Respondent was sentenced after being found guilty of one count of §18-3-402(1)(a) Sex Assault overcome victim's will, a Felony, and two counts of §18-3-404(1)(a) Sexual Contact no consent, a Misdemeanor, in Case No. 2019CR148 in the Adams District Court. The respondent was employed as a peace officer on the date of the offense (Date of Offense: February 11, 2018, Adams County Sheriff's Office, Separated January 16, 2019). The Respondent has not complied with POST Show Cause Order No. F22-05 by failing to appear at the scheduled Show Cause Hearing on July 11, 2022. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of Michael R. Benson's Colorado Peace Officer Certification, PID CO-134872.
- No. F22-06, Austin Scott Hopp, Certification PID CO-4769-0642. On May 5, 2022, Respondent was sentenced after being found guilty of one count of §18-3-203(1)(i) Assault 2 - Strangulation, a Felony, in Case No. 2021CR876 in the Larimer District Court. The respondent was employed as a peace officer on the date of the offense (Date of Offense: June 26, 2020, Loveland Police Department, Separated April 30, 2021). The Respondent has not complied with POST Show Cause Order No. F22-06 by failing to appear at the scheduled Show Cause Hearing on July 12, 2022. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of Austin Scott Hopp's Colorado Peace Officer Certification PID CO-4769-0642.
- 4. No. F22-07, Shawn Lee Sanchez, Certification PID CO-100081. On May 2, 2022, Respondent was sentenced after being found guilty of one count of §18-6-401(1)(a),(7)(a)(III) Child Abuse-know/reckless Cause SBI-att, a Felony, in Case No. 2021CR118 in the Delta District Court. *The respondent was not employed as a peace officer on the date of the offense (Date of Offense: January 1, 2019).* The Respondent has not complied with POST Show Cause Order No. F22-07 by failing to appear at the scheduled Show Cause Hearing on July 12, 2022. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of Shawn Lee Sanchez's Colorado Peace Officer Certification PID CO-100081.

Misdemeanor Convictions:

 No. M21-11, Joshua Michael Cabello, Certification PID CO-1150-4011. On December 1, 2021, Respondent was granted a deferred sentence after pleading guilty to one count of §18-3-204(1)(a), Assault 3 – know/reckless cause injury, a misdemeanor, in Case No. 21CR1030 in the County Court of Pueblo County. The respondent was employed as a peace officer on the date of the offense (Date of Offense: July 17, 2021, Crowley County Sheriff's Office, Separated July 19, 2021). The respondent has not complied with POST Show Cause Order No. M21-11 by failing to appear at the scheduled Show Cause Hearing on March 2, 2022. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of Joshua Michael Cabello's Colorado Peace Officer Certification, PID CO-1150-4011.

Untruthfulness:

- No. U22-08, Jonathan Aaron Carrasco, Certification (PID CO-139778). On March 2, 2022, Douglas County Sheriff's Office notified Colorado Peace Officer Standards & Training that the Respondent knowingly made an untruthful statement concerning a material fact or omitted a material fact during an internal affairs investigation, and during an administrative investigation and/or disciplinary process between August 19, 2020, and February 18, 2022 (Date of Separation: February 19, 2022). The respondent did not request a Show Cause Hearing regarding this matter. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of Jonathan Aaron Carrasco's Colorado Peace Officer Certification (PID CO-139778).
- No. U22-14, William R. Hodge, Certification (PID CO-135649). On April 25, 2022, Weld County Sheriff's Office notified Colorado Peace Officer Standards & Training that the Respondent knowingly made an untruthful statement concerning a material fact or omitted a material fact during an administrative investigation and/or disciplinary process on March 24, 2022 (Date of Separation: April 15, 2022). The respondent did not request a Show Cause Hearing regarding this matter. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of William R. Hodge's Colorado Peace Officer Certification (PID CO-135649).
- 3. No. U22-15, Robert W. Mesch, Certification (PID CO-116085). On May 5, 2022, Adams County Sheriff's Office notified Colorado Peace Officer Standards & Training that the Respondent knowingly made an untruthful statement concerning a material fact or omitted a material fact during an internal affairs investigation on November 9, 2021 (Date of Separation: April 21, 2022). The respondent did not request a Show Cause Hearing regarding this matter. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of Robert W. Mesch's Colorado Peace Officer Certification (PID CO-116085).
- 4. No. U22-16, David S. Woods, Certification (PID CO-119059). On May 18, 2022, Pueblo Police Department notified Colorado Peace Officer Standards & Training that the Respondent knowingly made an untruthful statement concerning a material fact or omitted a material fact during an internal affairs investigation and during an administrative investigation and/or disciplinary process on October 12, 2021 (Date of Separation: May 3, 2022). The respondent did not request a Show Cause Hearing regarding

this matter. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of David S. Woods' Colorado Peace Officer Certification (PID CO-119059).

5. No. U22-17, Jennifer K. Chase, Certification (PID CO-7727-7800). On May 18, 2022, Sheridan Police Department notified Colorado Peace Officer Standards & Training that the Respondent knowingly made an untruthful statement concerning a material fact or omitted a material fact during an internal affairs investigation on February 28, 2022 (Date of Separation: June 1, 2022). The respondent did not request a Show Cause Hearing regarding this matter. POST Director Erik J. Bourgerie recommends revocation of Jennifer K. Chase's Colorado Peace Officer Certification (PID CO-7727-7800).

The named individuals failed to comply with the training requirements contained in § 24-31-315, C.R.S. The requirements for § 24-31-315, C.R.S. were due between June 30 and August 8, 2022. Each person was provided a 30-day compliance notice between August 1 and August 5, 2022, expiring between September 1 and September 8, 2022. None of the named individuals completed all of the training requirements as of September 9, 2022 and are still out of compliance.

Pursuant to § 24-31-315(2)(a), C.R.S., the POST Board shall suspend a peace officer's certification if the peace officer fails to comply with the training requirements in this section. The POST Board shall reinstate a peace officer's certification that was suspended upon completion of the training requirements.
