- 3. Discussion about the term "excited delirium" and its impact on training. Discussed
  - Following an article published by 9 news concerning the use of the term "excited delirium" during deaths that often involve police interaction, the committee discussed whether a response was necessary regarding ACT training in the area of Custodial Care where the term is found and covered in academies. Although the term was coined in the medical field and passed on to law enforcement, it has been used in law enforcement training to identify certain observable physical cues a person exhibits that may be suffering a medical event needing to be assessed by emergency medical personnel immediately. Police training has been in place for years in response to this type of situation, but there has been public concern in deaths where this term is attached by Coroner's offices as the contributing factor or cause of death. Because of this, the committee agreed it would be prudent to explore this issue to provide the POST Board with feedback where the committee stands with current training expectations outlined in the Arrest Control Program Custodial Care section that includes "excited delirium".
  - Sub-committee proposal Approved
