The primary objective of the Daniels College of Business Public Safety Leadership Development program is to further develop public safety emerging leaders in our local communities. Participants will gain insight into their personal style, capabilities, strengths, and weaknesses and in turn understand their team's capabilities, strengths, and weaknesses. Emphasis will be placed on developing leaders and understanding team dynamics. Collaboratively built in 2008 and fine-tuned by input from multiple agencies, this program combines world-class faculty with personal assessments, leadership exercises, analytical assignments, and challenging activities to provide a life-changing experience. The PSLD program was reviewed by the Colorado Peace Officer Standards and Training Office and there are funding options available for small and remote agencies through POST.

# PROGRAM STRUCTURE

We recognize that time is a most valuable resource; therefore this program is highly concentrated. The program compresses the very best content and resources into five days.

The first session will be held offsite at The Nature Place where participants will be removed from their day to day lives and immersed in the program. This offsite session allows for participants to engage in team building, classroom experiences, and networking opportunities. The Nature Place is a comfortable mountain retreat and conference center located on a 6,000 acre privately owned ranch, one hour west of Colorado Springs. The next two sessions are held online (fall) or in-person (winter and spring) and include both individual classroom participation and group/ team work. The dates and assignments are strategically spaced to allow participants to apply what they have learned and to return to the team with stories of success and insightful questions, further customizing the program as it progresses. The final session includes a graduation ceremony where supervisors and leadership teams are invited to attend.
